

Family In 1901 William aged 9 lived with his father John,

[35] a widower and colliery furnace labourer. His grandmother, Mary Ann Clarke [widow], was head of household and also resident were an uncle,

George 28, and two sisters Lizzie 13 and Edith 11.

In 1911 William is no longer living in Hem Heath and cannot be traced elsewhere. The census shows that his grandmother is still alive [81] and his father and Uncle George are still working as colliery furnace labourers and his sister Elizabeth seems to have had an illegitimate child, Thomas [3]
